### RONALD REAGAN SIGNATURE STAMP SERIES

On the evening of June 26, 1988, history was made. That evening, at the White House, the Ronald Reagan signature stamp was unveiled. This was the first and only stamp ever signed by a United States President. To make this evening even more memorable was the fact that only 25,000 of these privately issued stamps were printed by the American Bank Note Company who prints most of the U.S. Postal Service issues. This series was issued by the White House not the U.S. Postal Service.

Popular demand for this stamp has made the Ronald Reagan Series an outstanding vehicle for capital appreciation.

Below is a 25 month price performance summary of the Ronald Reagan Signature Stamp and First Day Covers, and a sixteen month history of the price performance of the "On Board Reagans".

These 500 sets of "On Boards" were on the inaugural flight of the hot air balloon pictured on the Ronald Reagan Signature Stamp piloted by Malcolm Forbes on July 9, 1988. The "On Boards" are stamped and validated so they can easily be identified as "On Board Reagans."
